A total of 16,60,511 students appeared out of 16,80,256 who registered for the CBSE 12th Exams this year and 14,50,174 students declared passed. The pass percentage for CBSE Result 2023 Class 12 was 87.33%.

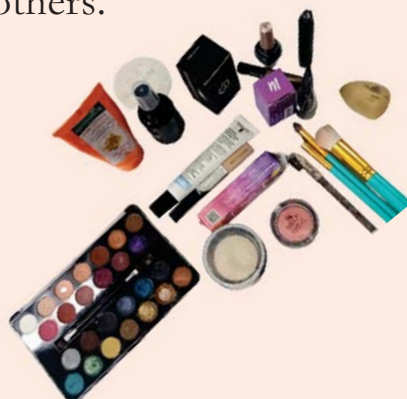




For Mother's Basic Makeup

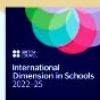
